



Playing format for Shoot Out Netball weekends

1. Teams to consist of at least 9 persons including a capable person to officiate as umpire. You can bring more and rotate your players from match to match. Players can only play for one team.
2. It will be a round robin tournament in the morning and versatility in the afternoon with a rotation system in place (see below)
3. There will be occasions when you will have an umpire on one court when your team are playing on the other but we do keep this to an absolute minimum.
4. Normal AENA rules apply. Except rule 4.4 regarding team numbers.
5. Captains to make sure all jewellery removed and finger nails are the appropriate length.
6. Scorecards will be provided for umpires, but please bring a whistle and pen/pencil.
7. Scorecards to be brought to the score table by captains at the end of each match.
8. 3 points awarded for a win, 2 for a draw and 1 for half your opponents score.
9. If teams are level on points at the end, the winner will be decided on goal average.
10. Please ensure that you are ready to take the court as soon as the previous match has finished.
11. There will be a 30 minute break for lunch, this may be reduced if running late.

The rotation for the afternoon versatility will be as follows;

GS ➡ GA
GA ➡ WA
WA ➡ C
C ➡ WD
WD ➡ GD
GD ➡ GK
GK ➡ GS

If you wish to bring in a new player **you do your rotation** and the player comes in at **WD**. If however you have more than 1 spare player you wish to bring in, you can bring in a **maximum of 3 players, after rotation at WD, GD and GK**

We rely upon your honesty to rotate correctly, to make this a fair and fun afternoon for everyone.

(Players with hangovers will be allowed on court, so no excuses)
