



Playing format for Shoot Out Skittles weekends

1. Each team will provide ten players per match and each match will consist of five legs lasting approximately one and half hours. In the event of singles and small groups we will place you into a team consisting of at least 10 players.
2. Teams can have more than 10 persons as teams can rotate their players from match to match ensuring all their players get a match. Players can only play for one team.
3. Teams can be all men, ladies or mixed and will play against all types of teams. Teams will play in a group of four, ensuring all teams play at least three matches in a round robin format, Friday evening, Saturday afternoon and Saturday evening with the winning team from each group competing in the final on Sunday afternoon.
4. The team with the highest score in each match will be awarded **2** points. In the event of a draw each team will receive **1** point. If after playing 3 matches two or more teams are level on points and a decision is required as to who is top of the group, a count back of pins scored over three matches will decide. If their total pins are the same then it will be based, if there are two teams drawn, on the result of the match between the two teams. The team that won goes through to the final. Should that match have ended as a draw then each team captain will select one player to represent the team in a three ball shoot out which will be staged just before the finals commence. If however, there are three teams on the same number of total pins scored, the three ball shoot out rule will again apply.
5. The final will be a SHOOT OUT between the teams winning their groups. This can vary from 2 teams in a final to as many as 12. If the final consists of more than 2 teams then the teams are competing for the highest pin score. The highest scoring team will win the top prize but all finalists will win prizes. If within the final any teams are tied on scores, each team captain will select one player to represent the team in a three ball SHOOT OUT. - The highest score with three balls.
