

## NEWQUAY

For the Newquay Coach Tour, the itinerary for the weekend could be as follows:

### FRIDAY

Coach to pick you up between 9:00am and 10:00am. Break the journey in a town or towns of interest on the way for about an hour for refreshments and walk around the shops. Break the journey once more at the famous Jamaica Inn on Bodmin Moor before arriving in Newquay just before 4:00pm.

### SATURDAY

After breakfast the coach will depart for the famous Eden Project. The group rate entrance charge is £10 for adults (£7 for over 60s). Those persons who do not wish to visit the Eden Project can stay on the coach which will proceed to Cornish Market World, the biggest indoor market in Great Britain, at St. Austell where it will stay for just over an hour. From there the coach will make a short drive to the ancient port of Charlestown, staying for around 40 minutes before driving along the coast to picturesque Mevagissey. The coach will return to the Eden Project at 3:30pm before making its way back to the hotel. If the majority of the party wish, a short stop could be made at Cornish Pearl, a large factory shop specialising in pearl jewellery, just outside Newquay.

### SUNDAY

This will be more of a general sight-seeing day visiting the cathedral city of Truro, then proceeding to visit Falmouth on the coast and breaking the return journey by stopping at the popular Pressingoll Barns for refreshment and perhaps make a purchase or two! Pressingoll Barns is well-known for its candle making, glassware, pottery, fudge and general gifts.

### MONDAY

Coach departs at 10:00am after breakfast breaking the journey in a town or towns of interest on the way home.
